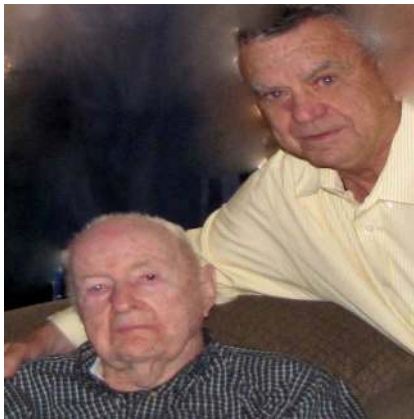

BOB HALLIDAY CELEBRATES 97TH BIRTHDAY WITH PIONEERS



It was a very special day for Bob Halliday when he was surprised by his Pioneer friends and family on his 97th birthday. Joe La Fontaine organized the event that brought together Bob's family and many of his close friends from the plastics industry. The Pioneers gathered at Bob's residence in Brea, CA to celebrate the special event and to reminisce about his 35 plus years in the plastics industry. Early in his career Bob joined

Wilson and George Myers as a technical representative providing service for their customers who purchased LDPE, PP, and Eastman Chemical cellulose. When the two companies merged Bob became Executive Vice President of Marketing and Sales, a position that he held until his retirement. Bob is a real Pioneer having begun his career in 1946 after completing his military service.

WARREN T. BUSCHMANN REMEMBERED

Warren T. Buschmann passed away in Pomona Ca. Mr. Buschmann was one of the first Western Plastics Man of the year. He was a 35 year member of the SPI and served as Chairperson in 1966-67.

He was an Indiana native and a graduate of Purdue University earning degree in Chemical Engineering.

He began his career with Union Carbide in New York. He was transferred to Los Angeles in 1954. He later joined the Maclin Company a division of Teknor Apex where he was the President until his retirement in 1989.

Paul Erskine, founder of

the Erskine-Johns Company passed away earlier this year.

Paul was a graduate of Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he studied mechanical engineering. He was an Army veteran and studied engineering at Stanford University as part of his military training.

In 1962 he founded the Erskine-Johns Company that specialized in glass fibers and reinforced plastics in Santa Clara, CA.

After selling the company he spent the last several years enjoying his family and traveling.
